- 4 large sun catchers
- 4 suction cup hangers
- 7 window paint tubes
- 1 tube of dry glitter
- paintbrush
- 10 sun catcher charms
- 1 silver necklace
- 1 silver bracelet
- elastic cord
- instruction sheet

Turn Sunlight into Art!

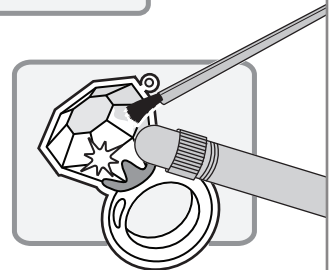
Watch these sun catchers glow from your window or wear them outside for a stained glass look on your jewelry! Paint your sun catchers & charms any color you like then add glitter for a shimmering work of art.

Painting Suncatchers

- 1** Choose a sun catcher & the paints you wish to use. Plan how you want to paint your sun catcher.
- 2** Squeeze a small amount of paint from the paint tube into the section you want to color. Use your paintbrush to spread the paint evenly.
- 3** While the paint is still wet, sprinkle dry glitter into it to add extra sparkle!
- 4** After the paint has dried completely, hang the sun catcher onto the suction cup hanger & stick to a window where lots of sunlight shines through.

ABOUT WINDOW PAINTS

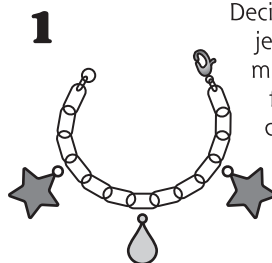
The window paints in your kit will look thick when wet but will dry clear.

Stained Glass Jewelry

Follow the above instructions for painting your sun catcher charms. Once they have dried completely, follow these steps for creating dazzling jewelry!



1

Decide which piece of jewelry you want to make & lay it out in front of you. Then choose the charms you want to use & lay them out where you want to attach them to the jewelry.

2

String the hole in the charm onto elastic cord. Then tie it onto the piece of jewelry between chain links & knot.
